

THE OUZO PROPHECY

I am Bob the Baptist,
Precursor of the Second Coming of Christ,
Whose name is Tor.
I can offer you precepts, poetry or ploys,
And even more.
I can offer you salvation
In a game called Ouzo.



Two thousand years ago, a soon-to-be best-selling author wrote about the evil of a city built on seven hills. It could have been today's Cincinnati, but it was yesterday's Rome. The author was John and the book was *Revelation*. His most famous and cryptic message to us bears repeating:

Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six.

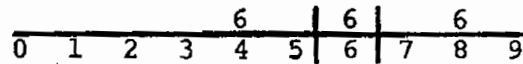
-*Revelation* 13:18

Serious Biblical scholars, including top Hollywood movie producers, have long pondered the satanic meaning of man, beast and number. Many of them believe the passage refers to former emperor Nero, who symbolized the pagan Roman Empire and whose very name adds up to 666 when an ancient number code is substituted for the letters. Others say the significance of 666 is that it falls short

of the mystical perfection of 777. It has even been suggested that 666 stands for the venal carbon atom of life (6 protons, 6 neutrons and 6 electrons). But all agree we are dealing with the evil of mankind.

Recently, an obscure local firm, in its eternal quest for a universal game, unlocked the secret of *Revelation* 13:18. The evil that lurks in the minds of men is manifested in the collective evil of the beast. Understand the man and you cannot be deceived by his institutions.

A simple bidding game of numbers provides an allegory. Let 666 represent our number system:



Each Group of Digits Adds to a
Number Whose Digits Add to Six

Each player has a set of random numbers from 0 to 9. The object is to make the highest bid of a number that does not exceed the combined total held by all the players. If the first player bids three 6's, he is predicting there are at least three 6's among all the players, including himself.

The next player can bid a higher number at that level (three 7's), any number at a higher level (four 5's) or pass. The end of the game is reached when a player makes

a bid that is passed all around. It will be a wise bid only if he understands the ploys and artifices of each and every player.

From the Greek language of *Revelation* comes the salvation of Ouzo, the ultimate game. But don't rush out to your nearest department store. The Ouzo Game Company will sell no game before its time. After all, it's been two thousand years in the making.

Notes on the Ouzo Cross

The Ouzo Cross is a symbolic representation of the struggle between good and evil, the Christ line versus the beast line. There are Ouzo combinations (repetitions of the same digit) and cryptograms based on English gematria simplex (A-1, B-2, C-3, etc.).

The Greek form of Jesus (Iesous) adds up to 888 in classical Greek gematria. This spelling of Jesus adds up to 88 in English gematria simplex (E.g.s.) and provides a mystical connection with our past. Christ adds up to 77, mankind to 66 and Satan to 55. Mankind is positioned between Christ and Satan in Ouzo combinations.

The ancient Greeks did not have numerals to express large numbers, and they accomplished this by arranging dots in geometrical patterns. A triangle meant the summation of a number. For instance, the number 3 triangulates to 6 (1 plus 2 plus 3). The number 11 triangulates to 66. Construction of the Ouzo Cross begins with a length of 66 units (mankind) with a top reference point of 77 (Christ) and a bottom reference point of 11. The beast is given power to continue 42 months (*Rev.* 13:5) until the Second Coming of Christ. This establishes the center of the Cross at reference point 53 (11 plus 42). Each arm of the Cross is 6 units, which again represents mankind (66). Both the top and bottom of the Cross are thereby shortened by 6 units.

Thus, the Ouzo Cross has the following reference points: top, 71; center, 53; bottom, 17; left, 47; and right, 59. They are all prime numbers. The left and

right are the nearest prime numbers to 53, while the top and bottom are the nearest prime numbers to 53 that also add up to eight.

The vertical line is the Christ line (888). The horizontal line is the beast line (beast equals 47 in E.g.s., and dragon, who gives the beast his power, equals 59). The 17 at the bottom of the Cross is a description of the beast (seven heads and ten horns) and the 71 at the top is a reflection of the beast. In the center of the Cross at 53 is Tor, which means *king* in the Tiv language of Nigeria, near the cradle of mankind. This will be Christ's new name that is promised in *Revelation* 3:12. The birth of Tor is described in Chapter 12.

The top portion of the Christ line is 18 units. This expresses 666 without regard to the positional value of the digits. The bottom portion of the Christ line is 36 units. This is the triangular expression of 666. The number 8 triangulates to 36, which triangulates to 666. The numbers triangulating to 666 are in the same 2 to 9 ratio as the beast line and the Christ line of the Ouzo Cross. Satan cast a third of the stars out of heaven (*Rev.* 12:4), leaving two-thirds or 666 stars out of a thousand. Two-thirds of God's light times one-third of Holy Trinity in the form of the Ouzo Cross repeats the ratio of 2 to 9.

There are two trinities in opposition:

<u>HOLY TRINITY</u>	<u>VS.</u>	<u>UNHOLY TRINITY</u>
Holy Spirit	Vs.	Satan
Jesus Christ	Vs.	False Prophet
Ouzo Cross	Vs.	Beast

In E.g.s., Holy Spirit equals 151, Jesus Christ equals 151 and Ouzo Cross equals 151. If Satan takes the place of the Ouzo Cross, the total adds up to "The Four Horsemen of the *Apocalypse*," described in Chapter 6 of *Revelation*. The ten crowns worn mockingly by the beast on his ten horns (*Rev.* 13:1) represent the three crowns of Holy Trinity in addition to the seven crowns of the world's continents worn by Satan the dragon (*Rev.* 12:3).
